



WHAT TO BRING

***Directions;** Please bring the studio address and directions with you. Leave yourself plenty of time so that you can arrive and relax prior to the lesson. You can very easily and quickly plan your journey at www.journeyplanner.tfl.gov.uk

CDs: Please bring something with you that you would like to sing. Your song can be something recorded by another artist, in which case please bring the song on CD (with the vocals on, so I can hear the voice qualities/melody) and the backing track if you have it (not essential). Backing tracks can be purchased from itunes (type in Artist and karaoke).

Sheet music (optional): If you have pitching problems it can be helpful for you to bring along sheet music for your song in addition to the audio. Sheet music can be bought very cheaply at musicroom.com or amazon.co.uk or any good music shop (Denmark street or Bond street if you are London based).

Leads: Please remember to bring leads for anything you wish to plug into the P.A e.g. guitar/ ipod.

Lyrics: Please bring in two copies of your chosen song lyrics (on A4 if poss. pref. typed). These can be found through any search engine on the internet.

Water: Please bring a bottle of water with you and drink water prior to the lesson.

Internet form: Please bring your downloadable internet form with you, filled in for your first lesson, this saves valuable lesson time.

Diary dates: It's my preference that you have a fixed regular lesson slot as this is the best way to progress but if this is not possible please bring provisional dates/times for your subsequent lessons with you.

Payment: Please bring full payment with you, to be paid at the beginning of the lesson (cash on the day or pre-paid via paypal 2 days before the lesson, I do not accept cheques).

Most essential! Always come with a good attitude and be ready to learn!
